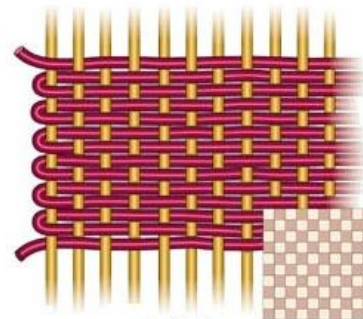
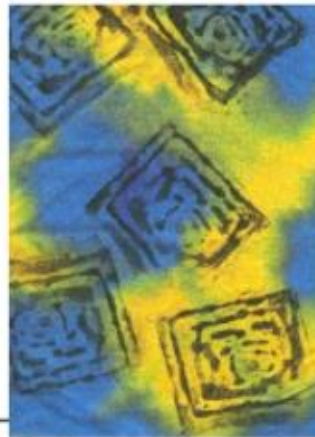
Methods

Relief printing - cutting or etching a printing surface in such a way that all that remains of the original surface is the design to be printed

Dyeing – Using brusho ink and cold water to dip dye white cotton material

Warping up – use warp threads to set up a loom frame

Tabby/Plain Weaving - creates a checkerboard pattern, which is created by alternating warp threads while adding the weft yarns.
