

Year 4 Computing: Creating Media - Audio Editing

Key learning:

Identify that sound can be digitally recorded.

Use a digital device to record sound.

Know that a digital recording is stored as a file.

Explain that audio can be changed through editing.

Show that different types of audio can be combined and played together.

Evaluate editing



Vocabulary

Audio	Recorded sound
Input	An input device sends the audio to the device's computer
Output	An output device allows us to listen to the audio
Copyright	A law that gives the owner of a recording (or other work), the right to decide what other people can do with it
Podcast	A type of spoken word audio file, that can be downloaded by the listener
Export	To save a copy of an audio file (or other document/file).
Layer	Combining more than one individual sound to create a single, more complete sound.
Combine	Mixing sounds together.
