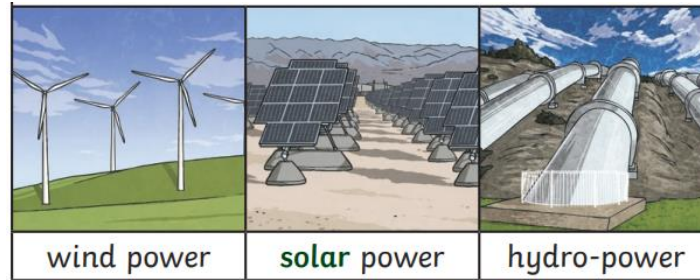


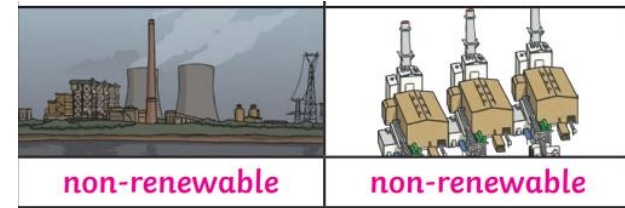

Key Vocabulary	
conserve	Use as few resources as possible
import	Buying products and goods from abroad
Non-renewable energy	A source of energy that will eventually run out e.g. coal and oil
Renewable energy	Created by resources that nature can readily replace such as wind, water and sunlight
Food miles	The distance an item has travelled from where it was produced to where it is consumed
Fertile land	Land that is rich in nutrients and very good for growing crops
