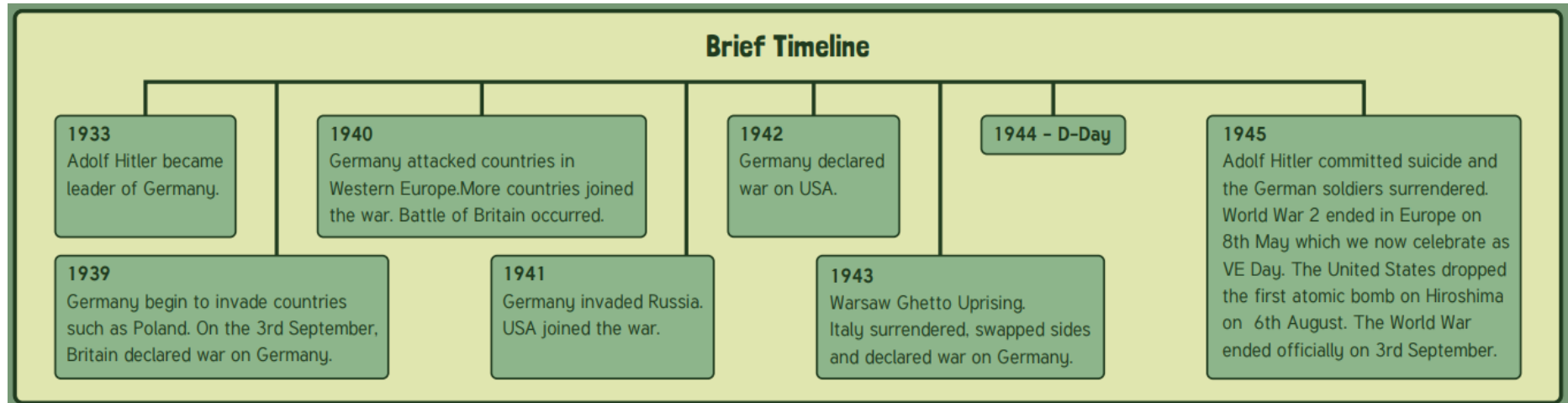


History: World War 2

Allies	The people who fought along side Britain e.g. France, America, China, Soviet Union
Axis	The people we were fighting against e.g. Germany, Japan, Italy
Blackout	When towns and cities are made dark so that they can not be seen by enemy planes
Evacuation	The process or relocating people from one dangerous area to a safer place
Air raid	An attack in which bombs are dropped from air craft on to a ground target
Adolf Hitler	The leader of Germany through out World War 2
